Before Thy Throne of Grace: A Celebration of Spirituals and Poetry

Come enjoy the liberating power and uplift of African-American spirituals, interspersed with readings from a classic of American poetry, *God's Trombones: Seven Negro Sermons in Verse*, by James Weldon Johnson read by Cecelia Hodges of the Witherspoon Church. Best known as the author of "Lift Every Voice and Sing," Johnson was also an author, educator, lawyer, poet, diplomat, newspaper columnist, songwriter and civil rights activist. In 1927, he wrote and published *God's Trombones* as a tribute to the old-time preachers he had heard in his childhood. Noel has paired the poems with spirituals sung by soloists and audience in response to hearing these engaging and inspiring verses.
