### Luke 14:1

On one occasion when Jesus was going to the house of a **leader** [literally: "ruler"] of the Pharisees to eat a meal on the sabbath, they were watching him closely.

### Luke 23:35

And the people stood by, watching; but the **leaders** [literally: "rulers"] scoffed at him, saying, "He saved others; let him save himself if he is the Messiah of God, his chosen one!"
