Son of Man

Daniel 7:13-14

As I watched in the night visions, **I saw one like a human being** [*literally: "son of man"*] coming with the clouds of heaven. And he came to the Ancient One and was presented before him. To him was given dominion and glory and kingship, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that shall not pass away, and his kingship is one that shall never be destroyed.

Luke 9:26

Those who are ashamed of me and of my words, of them the **Son of Man** will be ashamed when he comes in his glory and the glory of the Father and of the holy angels.

Luke 12:8

"And I tell you, everyone who acknowledges me before others, the **Son of Man** also will acknowledge before the angels of God;

Luke 21:27

Then they will see 'the **Son of Man** coming in a cloud' with power and great glory.

Luke 5:24

But so that you may know that the **Son of Man** has authority on earth to forgive sins" —he said to the one who was paralyzed—"I say to you, stand up and take your bed and go to your home."

Luke 6:5

Then he said to them, "The **Son of Man** is lord of the sabbath."

Luke 9:22

"The **Son of Man** must undergo great suffering, and be rejected by the elders, chief priests, and scribes, and be killed, and on the third day be raised."

Luke 18:31

Then he took the twelve aside and said to them, "See, we are going up to Jerusalem, and everything that is written about the **Son of Man** by the prophets will be accomplished.

The Kingdom

Luke 23:50-51

Now there was a good and righteous man named Joseph, who, though a member of the council, had not agreed to their plan and action. He came from the Jewish town of Arimathea, and **he was waiting expectantly for the kingdom of God.**

Luke 8:1

Soon afterwards Jesus went on through cities and villages, proclaiming and bringing the good news of the **kingdom of God.**

Luke 10:8-9

Whenever you enter a town and its people welcome you, eat what is set before you; cure the sick who are there, and say to them, 'The **kingdom of God** has come near to you.'

Luke 12:32

"Do not be afraid, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the **kingdom.**

Luke 18:17

Truly I tell you, whoever does not receive the **kingdom of God** as a little child will never enter it."

Luke 9:27

But truly I tell you, there are some standing here who will not taste death before they see the **kingdom of God."**

Luke 13:18-19

He said therefore, "What is the **kingdom of God** like? And to what should I compare it? It is like a mustard seed that someone took and sowed in the garden; it grew and became a tree, and the birds of the air made nests in its branches."

Luke 13:28-29

There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth when you see Abraham and Isaac and Jacob and all the prophets in the **kingdom of God**, and you yourselves thrown out. Then people will come from east and west, from north and south, and will eat in the **kingdom of God.**
