## Timeline

722 BCE	Fall of Israel (northern kingdom) to Assyria
586	Fall of Judah (southern kingdom) to Babylonians
538	Exiles return from Babylon after Persians defeat Babylonians; begin rebuilding Temple
516	Second Temple completed and dedicated
332 312	Alexander the Great conquers Israel/Palestine Ptolemaic (Greek-Egyptian) rule over Israel/Palestine
198	Seleucid (Greek-Syrian) rule over Israel/Palestine
166-60	Maccabean Revolt; beginning of period of limited Jewish independence
175-50	Many of the Dead Sea Scrolls written
63	General Pompey takes Jerusalem; beginning of Roman rule of Israel/Palestine
4 BCE	Jesus born
30 CE	Jesus crucified
50-58	Paul writes his letters
66-70	Jewish rebellion against Rome; Temple destroyed
70-120	Gospels of Mark, Matthew, Luke, and John, other NT literature written
